Day 1: Arrival - After touching down in Santiago you will be transferred to your hotel.

After the tour you have free time to explore on your own or to catch up on sleep after your long flight.

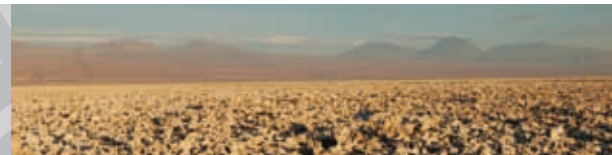
Day 3: Wine Tour - Today we explore the world famous vineyards of the Maipo and Casablanca valleys. These two valleys, close to Santiago, produce some of the finest wine on the continent. ## Atacama Dreaming

Day 1: Transfer from Calama to San Pedro de Atacama. On route you will see spectacular views of the Cordillera de la Sal. Remainder of the day is free.

Day 2: In the morning we visit the archaeological museum of Padre le Paige, with its famous collection of artefacts from Atacameño society. We also visit the church of San Pedro which dates from the 17th century. In the afternoon we visit the Valley of the Moon to see the sunset.

Day 3: Free morning to enjoy the silent atmosphere of the desert or to visit the nearby pre-Inca fortress of Pucara de Quitar. This afternoon we visit the Salar de Atacama via Toconao. The houses in this small village are built of white volcanic stone, giving the town a very unique appearance. After Toconao we continue on to visit the world's largest salt lake: the Salar de Atacama.

Day 4: Early departure for the geysers of El Tatio. El Tatio is situated at an altitude of 4,500 m above sea level on the Altiplano. The geysers are spectacular in the early morning as the rising sun strikes the steam. We then travel back to Calama.
